MARK YOUR SELECTION(S):

Small Share \$300

Designed for a couple, a couple friends, or as a sampler for a family, this size of share is great for those wanting to see what this seasonal eating is all about! You'll receive at least 4 items weekly, most of which will be familiar vegetables.

Standard Share \$450

Designed for a family of 2-4, depending on your vegetable consumption. This share will focus on basic vegetables, often with a twist. Expect staples such as potatoes and tomatoes, but look forward to new tastes, colors and textures of these old favorites.

Veggie Lover Share \$600

Enough for a veggie-lovin' family of 4 or more, or for two families to split. (You are responsible for splitting your own box.) The Veggie Lover Share will also have greater variety, with less common vegetables such as fennel, Asian greens, and a variety of fresh herbs.

Egg Add-on \$35

Receive a dozen local eggs every other week, for two a month and a total of 10 dozen total. May only be purchased in addition to one of the vegetable shares.

Market-Style CSA—Pack Your Own

This year we'll be distributing shares at one central location every Thursday. In this market-style technique, members will pack their own boxes or bags from our pre-determined list of produce. Pick up your vegetables between 3:30-6:30pm at the parking lot of the Westminster Presbyterian Church (27th and South). CSA members receive shares for 20 weeks. Including two scheduled breaks, CSA will run from May 24th to October 25th. More CSA details can be found on our website.

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

Option 1 Pay the full balance for your share. Make checks payable to Community CROPS.

Option 2 Pay in two halves. Include 2 checks, one dated with the current date, and one for June 1, each for half the balance. For Small Shares, each check should be for \$150. For Standard Shares, each check should be for \$225. For Veggie Lover Shares, each check should be for \$300. Add \$17.50 to each check if adding the egg-share. Make checks payable to Community CROPS.

Option 3 Submit the Scholarship Application with this Registration Form to be considered for our "Share-a-Share" program. Scholarship availability is determined by donations from the community. We will contact you by May 1 to notify you of your approval and set up a payment plan. **EBT/SNAP accepted!**

Work-Share Discounts are available through our work-share program. Contact us if interested in participating as a work-share volunteer for the 2012 CSA. Volunteers must commit to 3 hours/week, working on one of the following: member communication, distribution site assistance, harvesting, events, or organizational tasks.

BRANCHED OAK CHEESE ADD-ON:

New in 2012, we're partnering with Branched Oak Farm, located outside of Raymond, NE, to offer our CSA members a cheese share add-on to pick up with your vegetables. Krista Dittman, owner and operator, along with her husband Doug, will be handling the majority of communication with those interested in this add-on. Check box, then see additional form for options and payment (separate from your produce share with CROPS).
